(_____) High School has clear safety expectations for all drivers. All students must register their cars and agree to the following *Safe Behavior* rules if they plan to drive a car and park at the school during school hours, special events, and sporting events. It is important that all students, parents, and visitors are safe whether they are walking, driving, or a passenger in a vehicle on school property or parking lots.

Safe behavior includes:

- Student drivers and passengers wear seat belts while the vehicle is in motion.
- New drivers agree to limit passengers and comply with the Wisconsin Graduated Driver License Law
- No cell phone communication, talking or texting is allowed while the vehicle is in motion.
- No alcohol or drugs in the vehicle at any time.
- Students need to drive 10 miles per hour or less in the parking lot, driveways, and roads connecting the campus buildings and sports venues.
- Courteous behavior is expected by waiting for pedestrians and other vehicles to pass.
- No horseplay, riding on sideboards or hoods, is allowed at any time.
